






















































Insert the **round bar** into the wooden ball. Put the rod through the star, shorten it to fit and put awooden ball on the end again.

Shorten the round bar to any length and insert it into the wooden disc. Put a wooden ball on the end. Apply hot glue to the top of the ball and place one of the wooden balls in the middle of the star.
