

# Shield with motif straw silk

**Instructions No. 1620**

Difficulty: Advanced 

Working time: **45 Minutes**

A **sign in the garden** is a great eye catcher! Make a decorative sign for yourself or give it away at the next garden party.

First **prime** the sign **and** an embossing foil **with white Acrylic paint and let** it dry

Now draw the **outlines of your lettering** with a pencil. In our example, we have used the "garden" lettering in the handlettering technique and traced it with moss green Acrylic paint . With a **black Marker** we have added **accents** to the lettering to make it even more effective. The milled lines on the sign have been emphasized with olive Acrylic paint

Cut from the **Motif straw silk** the desired motifs and glue them with **Napkin varnish** on the stamping foil. Allow to dry. Then emboss the motifs by tracing and emphasising **the contours** on the back of the stamping foil with an embossing pen or similar. Now cut out the motifs and glue them to the wooden shield using hot glue.

If you want to hang the sign **outside**, where it is also exposed to strong weather conditions, we recommend to hang the sign with **Clear varnish** to treat.
