Sisal basket

Instructions No. 1885

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 1 hour 30 Minutes

Decorative objects made of natural fibres are becoming more and more popular in your own four walls. After all, they don't only look nice, but are also a sustainable alternative to conventional baskets made of plastic. They also offer an incredible amount of space for toys, wool, blankets or can be used as a laundry basket or wastebasket. For this basket we have used one made of Cord sisal, as it is particularly tear-resistant and robust.



This is how the basket of sisal is made:


Wind the **Cord** in a circle until you get a diameter of about **26 cm**. Fasten it Cord with **hot glue**. To make a basket, the next layer is glued to Cord the last row of the lower circle. Now wind it Cord until you have reached a height of about 25 **cm**

For the handles, glue a piece of the sisal cord to the Cord basket and form a loop where the handle is to be made. This is not glued on. Afterwards you lead it Cord again on the Cord last row of the sisal cord and glue it there Cord again on the last row up to the point where the second handle is to be created. There you repeat the procedure described above. Then proceed with the next two rows in the same way as the row just described

In this way you can make baskets in different sizes.

Note: For this basket with the size Ø 26 cm x height 25 cm you need 4 sisal cords with a length of 15 meters each.
