## Stylish stamp mural

**Instructions No. 3070** 

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 2 Hours 30 Minutes

Discover here how you can create a stylish mural yourself in an ingeniously simple way with DIY Stamps yourself. You will need only painting board, some paint and painting sponges. Have fun stamping!



First, use a soft pencil to draw a frame 8 cm away from the edge. Use crepe-adhesive tape to mask off the frame line. If you now prime the rectangular area in this frame with beige paint, it will be easier to create a clean frame. Cut the round VBS Painting sponges in the middle. These work excellently as DIY Stamps.

So that you can stamp your picture as cleanly as possible, apply only a little paint to the cut, dry sponge with a brush. Stamp on the paint as whole or half circles according to your personal preference. For our decoration example, we used the craft colors white and pastel-olive green.


Tip: Didn't quite get a stamp right? Use a brush and some paint to carefully conceal small mistakes.


Once you are happy with your picture, leave it to dry.

Finally, you can attach picture eyelets to the back of your new artwork. Make sure that you insert a piece of

wood approx. 3 to 4 mm thick between painting board and the eyelet when screwing it on so that the screws do not push through to the front of the painting board .
