1. The Right Fimo Choice

There are different types of Fimo: Classic, Soft, Professional, and Kids. Choose the variant that suits your skills and projects. Fimo Classic is slightly harder, perfect for experienced crafters.

2. Oven-Hardening Properties

Fimo is baked at 110°C for 30 minutes to harden. To save energy, bake multiple pieces at once whenever possible.

3. Maintain Freshness

Fimo can easily dry out. Therefore, store it airtight, for example, in plastic bags, after opening.

4. Clean Workspace

Work on a clean, smooth surface as Fimo attracts dust and dirt. A clean environment is crucial for clean results.

5. Safety First

Fimo is non-toxic, but should not be ingested in large quantities. Ensure that young children do not craft with it unsupervised.

6. Cleaning Fimo

Dirty Fimo can be cleaned with a knife before baking or with fine sandpaper after baking.

7. Durability through Varnish

Use a special [Fimo varnish](#) to make your creations more durable after baking. It is available in matte and glossy.

8. Increase Stability

When modeling long and thin pieces, add extra stability with small wire pieces. These can be baked without any issue.

9. Use of Color Diversity

With over 50 colors, you can let your creativity run wild and even create your own color mixes to get exactly the shade you need.

10. The Right Tools
