
Zentangle drawing technique

Zentangle: relaxation through creative drawing

Zentangle is a meditative method that not only masters the pleasure of the pencil, but is also ideal for beginners. You don't need any drawing skills to get started with Zentangle. What is Zentangle?

Zen is a term that is often used in connection with meditation and tranquillity. But what does it have to do with drawing? Zentangle combines "Zen", i.e. meditative contemplation, with "tangle", which means clutter or

confusion. This special drawing technique is suitable for promoting relaxation and creativity without worrying about technical perfection.

The Zentangle method

Zentangle is like drawing to relax. You may know the feeling of being absorbed in doodling during a phone call or other everyday situations. This relaxed but focused drawing is the Zen aspect of Zentangle. The patterns you create are tangles - abstract, intricate lines. Zentangle requires no special skills, but offers space for relaxation and fun. Existing books and templates will help you to find creative ideas for your Zentangle. The variety of patterns gives the method structure so that it can be used by beginners and experienced artists alike.

How do I draw a Zentangle?



Zentangles are typically drawn on small tiles. These tiles are made of thick artist paper so that fineliners won't show through later. The process begins with sketching with a <u>pencil</u>. Rulers and erasers are usually taboo, as the natural imperfection gives each Zentangle its own special touch. If you still want to make corrections, <u>kneaded erasers</u> are a clean and flexible solution. They also help to create shadows and depth for added texture.

First sketch your Zentangle lightly with a pencil. Then go over it with a <u>fineliners for Zentangle</u> - these are artist pencils with a thin, highly pigmented ink, ideal for clean tracing. Finally, you can add color to your Zentangle with <u>colored pencils</u>. You can add even more variety with <u>black tiles</u> that you can decorate with <u>white pens</u>.




Conclusion
