KNOTS USED:

Lark's head knot horizontal double half hitch knot diagonal double half hitch knot Square knot

PREPARING OUR WORKSPACE

To carry out this work, it is advisable to do it by hanging the hoop from a macrame frame, rack or coat rack, or any part of your house with light where you can hang it.

When working with such long ropes, it is preferable to hang them high, and work standing or sitting.


BEFORE STARTING

Cut 36 cords of 4,20 m length each and 2 cords of 75 cm each.

STEP BY STEP:

STEP 1:

Use the 36 cords (4,20 m) and fold them all in half and use a **lark's head knot** to attach the cords to the stick or working base.







STEP 2. Use the 75cm long rope, this will be our lead cord. Place it to the right of the strings 10cm from the top and work an **horizontal double half hitch knot** on this lead cord with the 72 cords.







STEP 3. With each group of 4 ropes we make a **square knot**. We make 18 square knots in this first row.





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STEP 4. For the next row, we keep two ropes on the right and two ropes on the left apart and again make groups of 4 ropes to make square knots. This row has 17 square knots.





STEP 5. For the next row, keep two more ropes on the right and two ropes on the left apart and make groups of 4 ropes again to make square knots. This row has 16 square knots.



STEP 6. For the next rows, leave two more ropes apart and continue making square knots. The last row we make has 1 square knot.










STEP 7. Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on this lead cord with the 35 next cords.






STEP 8. Do the same for the other side. This time on the 36 cords to the right, ending on the cord that was the lead cord in step 7.



STEP 9. Grab the 6th rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on the 5 cords to the right.



STEP 10. Repeat step 9 with ropes 12, 18, 24 and 30 on the right.



STEP 11. Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on this lead cord with the 29 next cords.



STEP 12. Repeat step 9 with ropes 6, 12, 18 and 24 on the right.

STEP 13. Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on this lead cord with the 23 next cords.



STEP 14. Repeat step 9 with ropes 6, 12 and 18 on the right.



STEP 15. Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on this lead cord with the 17 next cords.



STEP 16. Repeat step 9 with ropes 6 and 12 on the right.



STEP 17. Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on this lead cord with the 11 next cords.



STEP 18. Repeat step 9.

STEP 19. Grab the rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot 5 next cords.



STEP 20. Grab the 36th rope on the right, this will be our lead cord. We work a diagonal double half hitch knot on the 35 cords to the right.







STEP 21. Do the same for the other side. (Symmetrical steps 9 to 18)



STEP 22. Repeat the initial process of square knots in reverse order: start with a square knot with the central ropes and then add ropes (the second row will have two square knots, the third row will have three flat knots and so on. The last row has 18 square knots.



STEP 23. Use the 75cm long rope, this will be our lead cord. Place it to the right of the strings and work a horizontal double half hitch knot on this lead cord with the 72 cords.



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STEP 24. Unravel the rope's ends, cut them about 10cm. Brush them with the help of the comb. Do the same with the upper strings.











Note: Due to the fact, that Crafty Fine yarn is recycled from colour-assorted textile material and not re-dyed there can be slight variations in color and thickness. We therefore recommend buying enough yarn for your project. We also advise to use a crochet needle without handle, which is easier to work with. The first stitches might be a little bit hard to work, but you will soon get used, and the final result is worth it.

WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets. Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface. Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth. Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
