# Hat

**Design:** Käte Stödter

Knit



Easy



## SIZE

Approx. 54 - 56 cm head circumference

## MATERIALS

**Schachenmayr Alpaca Big**, 100 g ball

Approx. 100 g ≈ 50 m

Version A col. 00122 (yellow) 1 ball

Version B col. 00130 (poppy) 1 ball

Version C col. 00136 (pink) 1 ball

Version D col. 00147 (lilac) 1 ball

Version E col. 00151 (capri) 1 ball

Version G col. 00166 (lagoon) 1 ball

Double pointed needle (dpn) size 15.0 mm (US size 17/19)

1 cable needle

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

### Cable pattern:

7 st and 9 rows = 10 x 10 cm

## THE BASICS

### Ribbed pattern:

k1, p1 in alternation.

### Cable pattern:

**Rd 1:** \*p2, k3\***Rd 2:** \*p2, k3\***Rd 3:** \*p2, place 2 st onto a cable needle in back of the work, k1, then knit the st from the cable needle \***Rd 4:** \*p2, k3\*

Repeat from \* to \* = pattern repeat (= 5 st).

Repeat R 1 to 4 throughout.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 40 st, divide the st over 4 dpn = 10 st each needle and work in the round. Work 4 Rd in ribbed pattern. Continue in cable pattern, work the pattern repeat 8 times.

After 12 Rd working in cable pattern, begin with the decreases as follows:

**Rd 1:** at every pattern repeat knit the 2nd and 3rd knitted st together = 32 st.**Rd 2:** work without decreases.**Rd 3:** at every pattern repeat purl the 2 purled st together = 24 st.**Rd 4:** at every pattern repeat knit the 2 knitted st together = 16 st.**Rd 5:** k2tog throughout = 8 st

Cut the yarn, thread the yarn through the remaining st and pull together snugly. Weave in the end.

Weave in the end at the beginning of the work.

## ABBREVIATIONS

k	= knit
p	= purl
R	= row(s)
RS	= right side
st	= stitch(es)
WS	= wrong side
